

ROUTE 64 | NEWPORT / URI

Route 64 Newport/URI operates between the Kingston Amtrak station and the Gateway Center in Newport via the University of Rhode Island's Kingston and Bay Campuses and CCRI Newport. Overall, Route 64 has low ridership and productivity, with ridership strongest during the morning and afternoon peak periods.

Proposed Changes

Route 64 would be reconfigured to provide more consistent all day service.

- Operate via West Main and Broadway en route to Gateway Center on all trips.
- Serve Jamestown on all trips.
- Operate with consistent 60 minute frequencies during the peak hours, and 90 during the off-peak.
- Extend weekday service hours to 6:30 PM.
- Serve the Naval Undersea Warfare Center (NUWC) on only the first 2 inbound and last 2 outbound trips of the day.

Related Changes

- Route 14 West Bay local trips will be unified under a single alignment between Providence and Narragansett. Transfers between Routes 14 and 64 can be made at the Boston Neck Road park-ride lot. Transfers to Route 66 URI/Galilee can be made at the Kingston Amtrak station.
- Route 14 West Bay express trips would be replaced by a new Route 68X Newport Express via West Bay, providing three inbound peak period trips and three outbound peak period trips to Providence each day.
- A new Route 60X Newport Express via East Bay would also be introduced. It will operate three inbound peak trips and three outbound peak trips via West Main Road and Metacom Avenue, making limited stops.
- The schedules of local services at Newport's Gateway Center would be coordinated to facilitate transfers on an hourly basis between Routes 60, 63, 64 and 67.
