

ROUTE 78 | BEVERAGE HILL/NEWPORT AVE

Route 78 Beverage Hill/Newport Avenue is a long circumferential route that operates between the Pawtucket Transit Center and Kennedy Plaza via East Providence.

Proposed Changes

Route 78 would continue to operate along a similar alignment as at present, but with changes to streamline and operate service consistently.

- Discontinue front door service to Rumford Towers (passengers could access the regular stop on Pawtucket
 Avenue less than a four minute walk away), along Pleasant Street to the Massachusetts State Line, and service
 on New Road all due to low ridership. This would speed service for the majority of riders and allow for
 service to be provided at more consistent frequencies over the day.
- Operate weekday service with consistent headways of 60 minutes.

Related Changes

- Route 35 Rumford/Newport Avenue would be extended to the South Attleboro MBTA station, providing connections to the commuter rail. Route 35 would no longer serve the Stop & Shop on Cottage Street, a destination that would now be served by Route 76 Central Avenue
- Wampanoag Plaza would serve as an East Providence "super-stop," with Route 33 Riverside, 34 East Providence, and 78 serving this location.
- Angell and Waterman Streets on Providence's East Side would become a Transit Emphasis Corridor, served by Routes 40 Butler, 35 Rumford and 78. Together, these services would provide frequent bus service at about 20 minute intervals.

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
