ROUTE 90C PARK-N-RIDE | CUMBERLAND

Route 90C is one of four "90-series" express routes that all operate as "Route 90 Park-n-Ride Commuter Service." Route 90C operates between the Blackstone River Visitor Center on I-295 in Cumberland and downtown Providence, largely along Route 146. In addition to the Blackstone River Visitor Center Park and Ride Lot, it also serves the Chimney Hill Apartments Park and Ride Lot in Cumberland and the Lincoln Mall Park and Ride Lot in Lincoln. The route duplicates service that is provide by Route 54 express trips.

Proposed Changes

Route 90C would be discontinued and replaced by new Route 54X North Smithfield Express service between North Smithfield and downtown Providence.

- Discontinue service beyond Lincoln Mall due to very low ridership, and replace with new Route 54X Woonsocket Express that would operate between a new park and ride lot at Brigido's Market (900 Victory Highway) in North Smithfield and downtown Providence. From the Brigido's Market park and ride lot, service would operate to the Lincoln Mall Park-n-Ride lot, and then express to Kennedy Plaza (bypassing CCRI and Twin Rivers).
- Route 54X would operate on weekdays and provide three AM inbound and three PM outbound trips, compared to two AM inbound and two PM outbound trips on Route 90C.
