

## ROUTE 92 | FEDERAL HILL – EAST SIDE (RENAME 92 RHODE ISLAND COLLEGE/FEDERAL HILL/EAST SIDE)

Route 92 operates between Eagle Square and the East Side Marketplace via Federal Hill, downtown Providence, Brook Street, and Fox Point. It provides unique service to a number of major activity centers and, with the exception of its service to the East Side Marketplace, is very direct.

Route 92 would be combined with Route 26 Atwells Avenue/RI College to provide frequent through service (every 20 minutes throughout the day) between Rhode Island College and the East Side Marketplace via Federal Hill and College Hill. Very low ridership variant service would also be discontinued to provide consistent service throughout the day.

## **Proposed Changes**

- Consolidate Route 92 with the Route 26 Atwells to develop a new Route 92 that operates between the East Side Marketplace and Rhode Island College via College Hill, downtown Providence, and Federal Hill.
- Provide more frequent service (every 20 minutes) and later service (until 11:00 PM on weekdays).
- Extend evening service to East Side Marketplace until stores close.

## **Related Changes**

- Since Route 92 would provide Sunday service to RIC, Route 27 Broadway Manton limited Sunday service to and from RIC would be discontinued.
- Route 55 Admiral/Providence College, which would be shortened to operate between Fatima Hospital and downtown Providence (no longer serving Rhode Island College) as the upgrades in service on Route 92 to Rhode Island College would make existing Route 55 service there redundant and to enable schedule improvements on the reconfigured Route 55.
- Route 26 Atwells, which would be combined with Route 92 as described above.
