ROUTE 99 | NORTH MAIN/PAWTUCKET (REPLACED BY R-LINE)

Route 99 operates between the Pawtucket Transit Center and downtown Providence. In Pawtucket, service generally alternates between Main Street and Pawtucket Avenue, and in Providence it operates via North Main Street. Route 99 is also through-routed with Route 11 Broad Street to provide through-service along Broad Street to the Providence/Cranston city line.

Proposed Changes (same in both Scenarios)

Routes 11 and 99 will be formally combined and upgraded to RIPTA's first Rapid Bus Line (the R-Line). This new route will provide faster and more frequent service with a high level of passenger amenities. For more information, see www.ripta.com/r-line-.

In Pawtucket, where Route 99 service alternates between Main Street and Pawtucket Avenue, all R-Line service will operate via Main Street. To replace Route 99 service now provided on Pawtucket Avenue, Route 71 Broad Street will be extended south from the Pawtucket Transit Center to the Ocean State Job Lot on Pawtucket Avenue.
