

ROUTE 22 | PONTIAC AVENUE

Route 22 operates between CCRI/Warwick and downtown Providence, primarily on Pontiac and Elmwood Avenues.

Proposed Changes

With Route 21 Reservoir redesigned to provide Key Corridor service along Reservoir Avenue and via the Pastore Center, Route 22 would be shortened to operate between the Warwick Mall and downtown Providence, and straightened to bypass the Pastore Center:

- Operate all between new Warwick Mall transit hub and Kennedy Plaza with regular, consistent headways, with primary service to the Rhode Island Mall and CCRI provided instead by upgraded Route 21 Reservoir service.
- Straighten the route to operate directly along Pontiac Avenue and not via the Pastore Center (which would instead be served by Route 21 Reservoir).
- Provide service with consistent schedules and adjust spans to reflect the provision on upgraded Route 21 Reservoir service:
 - On weekdays, from approximately 5:00 AM to 10:00 PM, every 30 minutes during the day and 60 minutes during the evening.
 - On Saturdays, from approximately 6:00 AM to 8:00 PM, every 60 minutes throughout the day.
 - On Sundays, from approximately 7:00 AM to 7:00 PM, every 60 minutes throughout the day.
