Ride Free Central Falls Pilot Extended Through December

RIPTA is happy to announce that we've extended the Ride Free Central Falls pilot program through December 31, 2023.



Under the pilot program, passengers can board for free at any bus stop in Central Falls and at the Pawtucket-Central Falls Transit Center when using the Wave smart card or Wave mobile app. Trips originating outside of Central Falls or the new intermodal center are required to pay the full fare.
