Passengers can board Flex 281(Woonsocket/Manville) to travel within the local Flex Zone, which includes Woonsocket and Manville, and also provides a connection to RIPTA's statewide service. To follow up on our first round of public listening sessions, we are now scheduling two virtual strategy sessions on Zoom later this month:



EMPLOYEE SPOTLIGHT: Ana Candelier, Flex Service Scheduler

Twenty years ago, Ana Candelier, a stay-at-home mom living in Cranston, joined the RIPTA team as a Customer Service Agent. She now works as a Flex Scheduler, making reservations for passengers traveling in any of RIPTA's six Flex Zones. Flex Service, offered in areas that have little or no fixed-route

service, gives passengers the option of picking up the Flex van at a scheduled stop or calling 24 hours in advance to reserve their own pick-up or drop-off points within the designated Flex Zone. Last year, Ana booked 44,311 Flex reservations.

What she loves most about her job is that "Everyone is a team player." This especially applies to Ana. Ana is native Spanish speaker, immigrating to the United States from the Dominican Republic and becoming a U.S. Citizen in 2000. When the Marketing & Communications Department asks her to proofread Spanish translations for passenger materials, Ana happily applies her linguistic skills.

Her supervisor Brooks Almonte, Executive Director Paratransit Division, describes her as "Dedicated, caring and knowledgeable."


